SCRA and Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center Charleston (SPAWAR) SIGN Cooperative Research and Development Agreement

Charleston, SC – April 3, 2008 – SCRA, a global leader in applied research and commercialization services, and SPAWAR Systems Center Charleston announced the signing of a Navy Cooperative Research and Development Agreement (CRADA). A CRADA is a written agreement between a company and a government agency to work together on a project.
