



Millennials have lost faith in traditional investments

- 4/5 Millennials don't have an investment account
- 64% of HNW Millennials prefer physical assets over stocks
- Accept higher risk or lower returns if investments create positive social or environmental impact

Evolving & Expanding Regulations

- JOBS Act (Reg A+) passed in 2012
- Title III (Reg CF) passed in 2016
 - Over \$600M raised through Reg CF
 - Over 1 million investors nationwide
 - Open access for all investors (with controls and limits for unaccredited investors)





Market Direction: Major Regulation Improvements

"Facilitating Capital Formation and Expanding Investment Opportunities"

Regulatory limits

- Maximum Raise: up to \$5MM per 12 months
- Accredited Investors: no investment limit
- Unaccredited Investors: investment limit based on income or net worth (whichever is higher)

Testing the Waters

- Unearthing new deals
- Gauging potential success

SPV / Investment Vehicles

- Dedicated OZ funds for certain deals
- Streamlines cap table management



The impact of local crowdinvesting:

- Supports diverse and inclusive opportunities for small business owners
 - Survey of issuers showed 86.4% had female and/or minority founders
- Wealth creation opportunities for all; not just the already wealthy
 - Open access for unaccredited investors and low investment minimums
- Supports local economic multiplier effect
 - Positive correlation between density of locally owned businesses and per capita job growth rate (HBR)
 and per capita income growth (ATL Fed)



Companies that may be a good fit:

- Resonates with the community on the need being met,
 the market opportunity, and shared values
- Benefit from the brand ambassadors, publicity, and local marketing of a public raise
- Post-revenue + has a local champion and lead investor

Friction-free investing:

- Online facilitation of funds flow, subscription documentation, and Special Purpose Vehicles (as applicable)
- Compliant offering page and disclosure packets
- Webinars and forums to interact with the Issuer
