

FY24 SACT Grant Program Track 2: Capacity Building PRE-APPLICATION FORM

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

The Capacity Building Track seeks to help eligible Institutions of Higher Education (IHE) in South Carolina build the infrastructure and capacity necessary for growth in use-inspired research activities, including establishing the framework and partnerships necessary for long-term sustainability of these program goals. Elements necessary for a compelling proposal include:

- Identifying and piloting at least one commercially viable technology through translational activities during the grant period, where the selected technology has a clear proof of concept and the potential to be positioned for federal SBIR/STTR or similar pre-seed funding in Year 3 of the program;
- Public/private partnerships, including a minimum of one industry partner, that leverage interests, assets, and expertise in a manner that achieves the program goals outlined above;
- Multi-institutional collaboration with at least one other IHE in South Carolina to achieve greater impact, reach, and efficiency across the state;
- A sustainability plan, including financial and non-financial resources for support and growth of the program after conclusion of the grant; and
- A multidisciplinary team, with at least one member of the project team having expertise in translational/useinspired research and technology transfer that can offer guidance and resources in achieving the program goals.
